



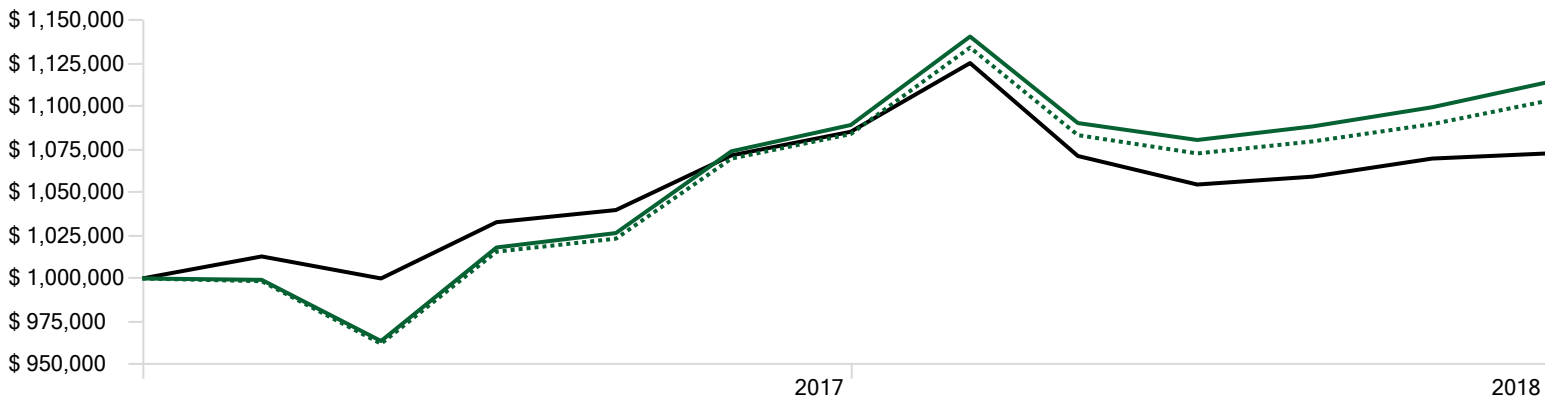

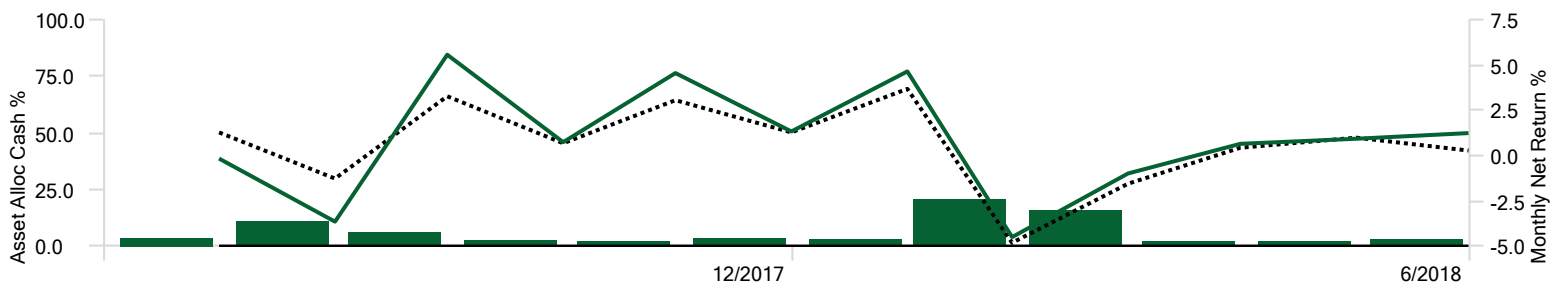

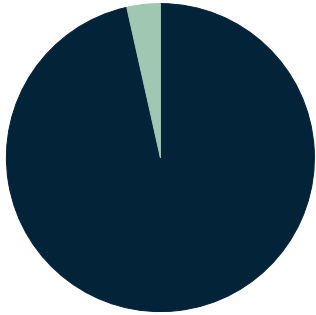
INVESTMENT STRATEGY

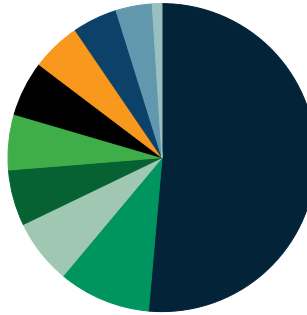

Alpha: measure of risk-adjusted non-excess return; positive Alpha indicates better performance than the given Beta (volatility) of the investment. **Beta:** measure of volatility relative to an index; Beta above 1 is more volatile than the index; Beta less than 1 is less volatile. **Up and Down Capture Ratio:** used to evaluate how well a manager performed relative to an index during periods when the index is up or down. **Maximum Drawdown:** measures peak-to-trough loss of an investment, indicating capital preservation. **Standard Deviation:** measure of volatility; greater STD indicates a more volatile strategy or index during a given time period. **Russell 3000 Value TR Index:** comprised of Russell 3000 companies with lower predicted and historical growth rates.

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
